Looking After Your Yard

Ways To Keep Your Yard Clean and Safe:

- ☛ Pick up garbage and place them into garbage cans ready for pick up.
- ☛ Pick up all pop cans/bottles and take them to the Bottle Depot or donate to Bottle-Drives.
- ☛ Take old furniture, unused appliances to the garbage facility at Bing's Creek.
- ☛ Properly store large toys, sports equipment and bikes.
- ☛ To stop rats and mice getting into the house, do not store piles of wood against the house.
- ☛ Discard broken gazebos, swimming pools or trampolines.
- ☛ If you have any old unused cars or boats have it removed.
- ☛ Mow the lawns regularly, long grass can attract rats and mice.
- ☛ Keep tree branches trimmed and not touching your house to keep out rats and squirrels.
- ☛ Remove all blackberry bushes from the side of the house and away from entrances.
- ☛ Keep your pets properly housed and clean up after them.
