All Finfish, shellfish

- All persons must obtain a permit from the Cowichan Fisheries under the Cowichan Tribes Communal Licence.
- Registered members do not require a permit for the in-river fishery However, a permit is required for all activity in marine areas.
- Non-registered members are unable to obtain a permit from Cowichan Tribes Fisheries for in-river and marine areas until further notice, due to low
- No use of canoes in river effective immediately until October 18th, when flows have increased. Canoes will be seized for 7 days on first offense, second offense will result in seizure until end of season.
