PURPOSE: The Cowichan River Hatchery was initiated in 1978 as a partnership between Cowichan Tribes and Fisheries and Ocean Canada to enhance the Cowichan and Koksilah River salmon stocks, obtain stock information, increase fish production, provide employment, contribute to the local economy and improve relations between the partners. As seasonal positions, the start dates and number of hours will vary by project. Reporting to the Cowichan River Hatchery Manager, these projects include:

1. Salmon counting fence: September - October
2. Deadpitch crew: October - December
3. DIDSON crew: November - December
4. Brood Stock crew: September - December

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Swift Water certification:
 - required for Counting Fence and Deadpitch
 - asset* for DIDSON crew
- SVOP (Small Vessel Operator Proficiency) Certificate
 - required for Deadpitch crew
- Valid BC Driver's License & Clean driver's abstract required
- Grade 12 or equivalent preferred
- First Aid certification is *an asset*
