Shtunni's tu Hwulmuhw replaces "Cowichan Indian Band Membership Rules and was the winner of the name contest that ran from June 2019–September 2019!

Cowichan Tribes has had Membership Rules (now known as *Shtunni's tu Hwulmuhw*) since 1986, and were last updated in 1992. The *Shtunni's tu Hwulmuhw* Working Group has been working hard to edit and update the law since June 2019.

Amendment Process:

- The Working Group reviews and edits the existing law, *Cowichan Indian Band Membership Rules* (1992), now known as *Shtunni's tu Hwulmuhw*.
- First-round of approval by Chief and Council for presentation to the *Qw'utsun Mustimuhw* (further edits may be made)
- Second-round of approval by *Qw'utsun Mustimuhw* (further edits may be made)
- Final approval: a vote by *Qw'utsun Mustimuhw* to implement *Shtunni's tu Hwulmuhw (2020)* and fully replace the Cowichan Indian Band Membership Rules (1992).

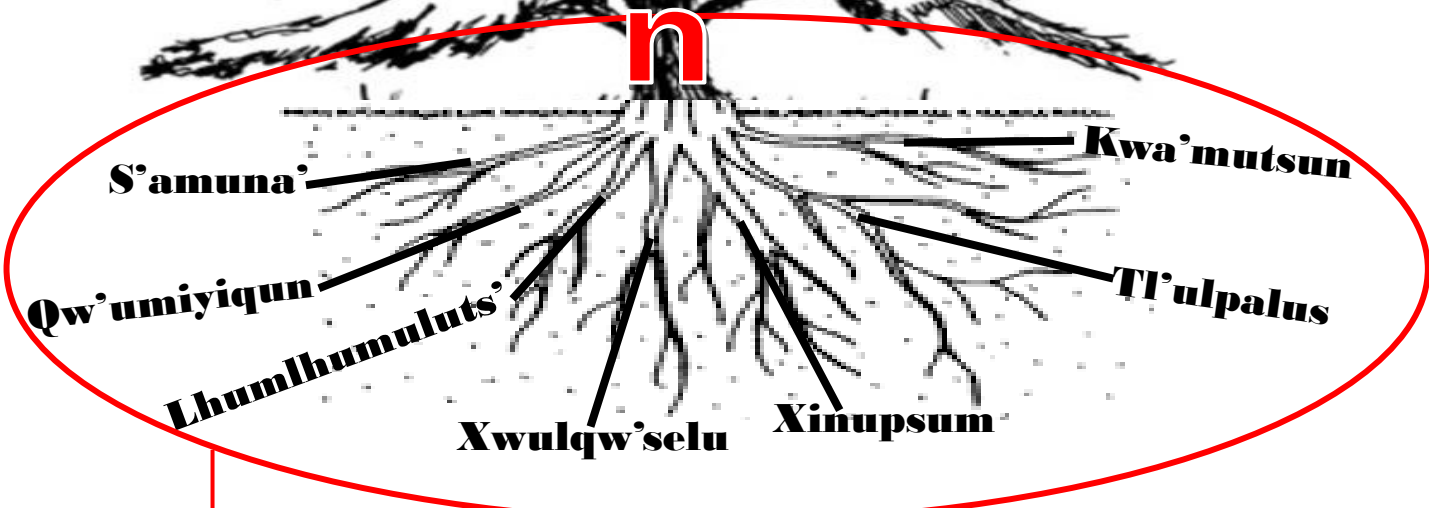
